Welcome to Third Grade! All rising 3rd grade students must read two books:

- “Freckle Juice” by Judy Blume
- “The Mouse and the Motorcycle” by Beverly Cleary

Each student is to pick a project to complete for both books. The activities will be due on Thursday of the first week of school. These two projects will count as your first grade for the year. Please do not wait to do it last minute.

Activities

(Choose one per book)

For the activity chosen, be sure to include the book title, author, and your name.

1. Draw and color a comic strip of your favorite scene or scenes in the book. Write one or two sentences explaining the scene. There should be at least four panels in your comic strip.
2. Create a collage of words and pictures about the story.
3. Create a new book jacket for the book. Include a picture with the title and author on the front cover and write a short summary on the back of your book jacket.
4. Write a different ending for your book. It should be at least one paragraph.
5. Make a diorama for the book. It should represent the setting and characters in your story.
